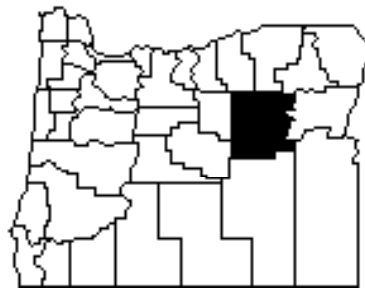


GRANT COUNTY, OREGON

- Unincorporated: 2,510 (33.3%)



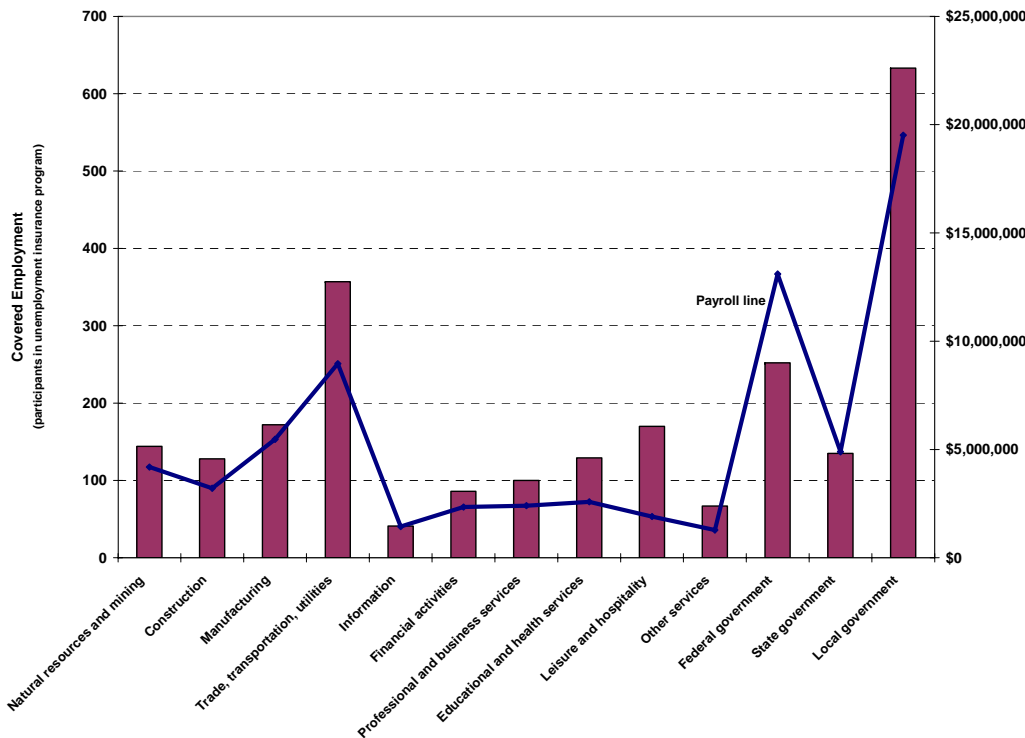
- Covers 4,528 square miles

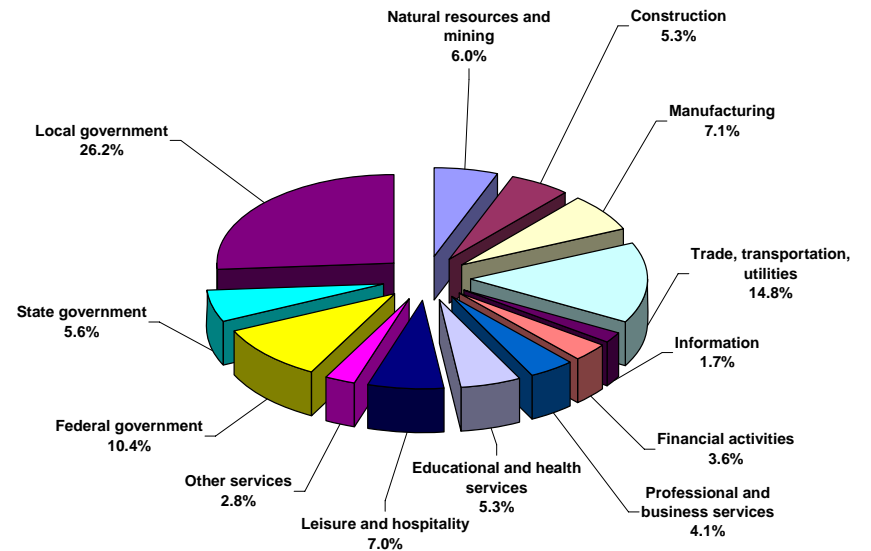
Grant County's 5 Highest-Paying Industries, 2008
